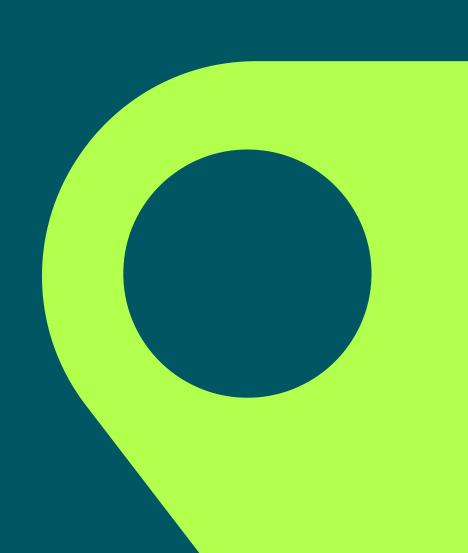

This is the address we have on record for your billing and customer correspondence.

Your account information

All your account details are here, including your account number; your distributor – the company that maintains the supply infrastructure for this site: and a contact number for power failure/emergencies. You'll also find the unique invoice number and invoice date here, along with the charging period for the invoice.

Your site information

In this section you will see:

- your site reference, site name and address of the site being invoiced
- your MPAN number (Meter Point Administration Number) a unique number used to identify electricity supply points
- our site reference number to identify the site being invoiced;
- Rota Block when under extreme supply versus demand conditions, groups of supplies may be disconnected, your Rota Block letter identifies your group.

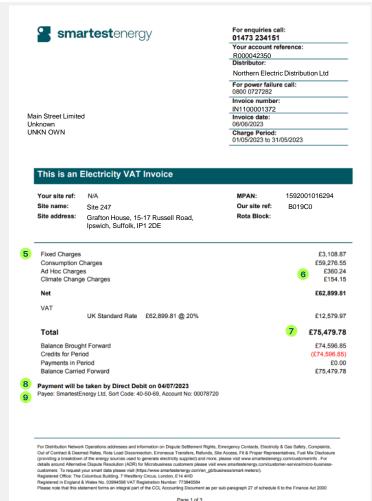

Electricity Used Page 2 (Fixed Charges)

Triad Estimate Charge

Transmission Network Use of System charge (commonly known as Triad) is the charge which recovers the cost of using the Transmission Network, this is an estimated monthly instalment which is reconciled following the publication of Triad dates and times by National Grid

11 Supply Standing Charge

Charges used to cover costs such as retrieving consumption data, maintenance and keeping the supply connected

12 CM Supplier Levy Cost (Estimate)

The Capacity Market Supplier Levy is the charge to cover Capacity Market payments to participants in this scheme. The cost of this scheme is based only on consumption during winter peak times of (Nov-Feb, Mon-Fri, 4pm-7pm) and the final published Capacity Market Supplier Levy rate

13 DUOS Fixed Daily Charge

Monthly charge which forms part of the Distribution Use of System charges to pay for the local distribution network

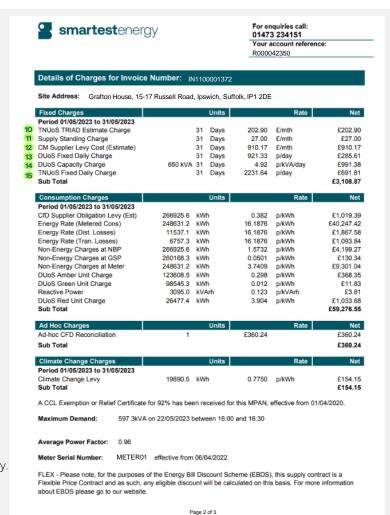
14 DUOS Capacity Charge

Charge for the agreed amount of electrical power that a supply can draw from the electricity distribution system

15 TNUoS Fixed Daily Charge

Transmission Network Use of System fixed daily charge is to cover the cost of using the Transmission Network; this is a set charge, rather than estimated and reconciled like TRIAD.

16 CfD Supplier Obligation Levy (Est)

The cost to cover payments for CfD generators, which is a £/MWh rate published on a quarterly basis by the EMR Settlements

- 17 Energy Rate (Metered Cons)
 - The energy rate for electricity used 24 hours a day
- 18 Energy Rate (Dist. Losses)

The charge for electrical losses in the distribution system whilst getting the electricity to site

19 Energy Rate (Tran. Losses)

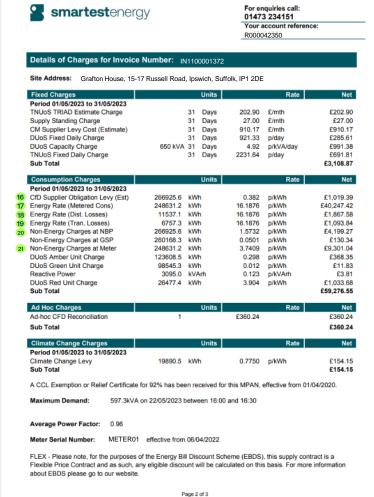
The charge for the electrical losses in the transmission system whilst getting the electricity to site

20 Non-Energy Charges at NBP

Charges issued from the Government and Ofgem for transporting your energy and various Government obligations (differs from product to product)

21 Non-Energy Charges at Meter

Charges issued from the Government and Ofgem for transporting your energy and various Government obligations (differs from product to product)

Electricity Used Page 2 (Fixed and Consumption Charges)

DUoS Amber Unit Charge

Charge to use local distribution network during times other than peak, nights and weekends

23 DUoS Green Unit Charge

Charge to use local distribution network during the night and weekends

24 DUoS Red Unit Charge

Charge to use local distribution network during peak periods eg. winter early evening

25 Climate Change Levy

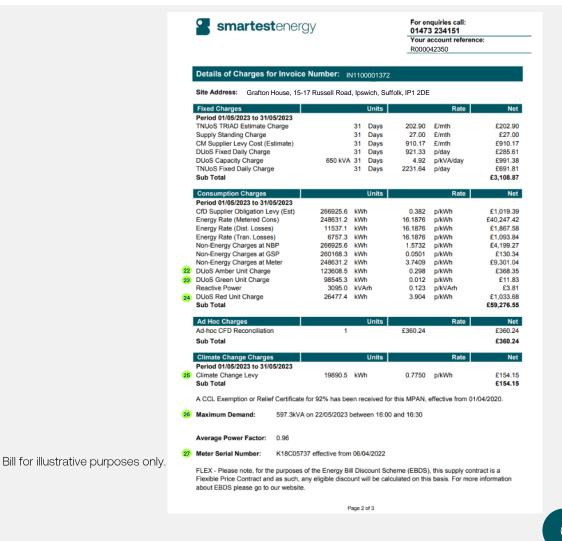
The content of the electricity supplied, this is the charge for the Climate Change Levy

26 Maximum Demand

The recorded date and time of your highest consumption

27 Meter Serial Number

The serial number of your electricity meter

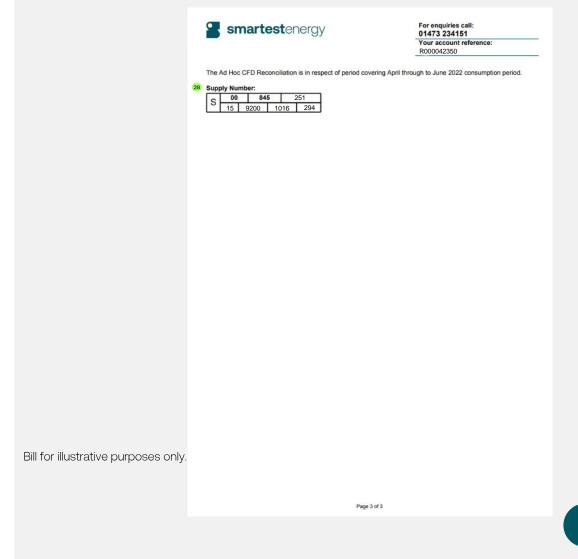




Electricity Used Page 3 (Climate Change Charges)
